



## Outstanding Chapter Award

**Outstanding Chapter Award**, is a team event (up to 3), plans and conducts a well-balanced Program of Work that supports strategic alignment with state and national Family, Career and Community Leaders of America (FCCLA). Participant(s) must be an affiliated member of the state and national organization and enrolled in a Family and Consumer Sciences course or related career field course. This award will be recognized at State Leadership Conference. The chapter must attend State Leadership Conference to receive the award.

### PROCEDURES AND TIME REQUIREMENTS

1. Participant must register during Career Development Event registration
2. Timeline is March 1 to March 1
3. Must provide information in an official FCCLA notebook or electronically using the official Ohio FCCLA PowerPoint template
4. Presentation may be up to 15 minutes in length. A one-minute warning will be given at 14 minutes. Participant(s) will be stopped at 15 minutes
5. Must provide digital photos and documents for evidence and statement highlighting the Plan of Work for recognition at State Leadership Conference

### CHAPTER OPERATIONS ACCOMPLISHMENTS (must complete all activities) – 4 points

1. Hold chapter meetings –minutes and agendas
2. Local leadership training for officers
3. Develop a yearlong Program of Work
4. Provided special services or participated in school wide activities

### PROGRAM ACCOMPLISHMENTS (must complete all activities) – 6 points

1. Implement projects relating to 2 of the Nationals Programs (select 2)
  - a. Career Connections
  - b. Student Body
  - c. Financial Fitness
  - d. STOP the Violence
  - e. FACTS
  - f. Leadership Service in Action
  - g. Families First
2. Participate in state Service Learning Project
3. Plan and implement activity for National Family and Consumer Sciences Day
4. Track Service hours in Portal for state recognition
5. Apply for State and/or National Programs Award

**PUBLIC RELATIONS ACCOMPLISHMENTS (must complete 5) – 5 points**

1. Implement activities highlighting National FCCLA Week/CAREER TECH Week
2. Publish articles in local or school newspaper(s), magazine(s) or publication(s)
3. Utilize social media to increase community awareness
4. Presentation to school board-civic organization - business/industry seeking awareness and support
5. Maintain a chapter website or Facebook page
6. Proof of submission of article to "Teens Times"

**EXCEPTIONAL ACCOMPLISHMENTS (select 3) – 3 points**

1. Identify how chapters create philanthropic awareness and/or financial support for the Ohio FCCLA Endowment
2. Identify how chapters create philanthropic awareness and/or financial support for the Ohio Alumni & Associates
3. Member is currently serving on Regional, State or National Executive Council
4. Member is currently a Regional or State Executive Council candidate
5. Members apply to present a workshop at National level
6. Write a grant for an FCCLA activity or project
