



Official Dress Code Policy

Effective July 2018:

Females

- Official blazer is required
- White collared dress shirt (long or short sleeves) with official neck wear from emblematic supplier
- Black dress slacks/pants/capris (no shorts)
- Black skirts – no shorter than 2 inches above the knee
- Black sheath dress
- Black dress shoes or sandals

Males:

- Official blazer is required
- White collared dress shirt (long or short sleeves) with official tie from emblematic supplier
- Black dress slacks (no shorts) • Black dress shoes Exception: Culinary Arts participants are welcome to wear their Chef's Attire during the STAR Events Recognition Sessions.

Advisers/ Chaperones/ Guests

- Business professional
- Jeans, t-shirts, athletic wear are NOT acceptable STAR Events participants are expected to adhere to the published dress code for all general sessions, workshops, and the STAR Events Recognition Session.

For participation in competition, follow event specifications for dress, and wear appropriate clothing for the nature of the presentation. If attending conference activities prior to or immediately after a STAR Events presentation, be prepared to change into clothing that meets the conference dress code.
