



Career Development Events Committee

Purpose:

Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America Association assumes the leadership role in developing and continuously improving industry relevant Career Development Events. State Career Development Events should reflect the application of technical knowledge and skills relevant to industry demands. Career Development Events are intended to be an extension of the classroom and laboratory instruction. In addition, it is appropriate for the state organization to develop Career Development Events that simulate instruction in emerging areas that reflects both current and future local, state, national and global workforce needs.

Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America Career Development Events should be developed with significant input from industry partners involved in Family and Consumer Sciences, Hospitality and Tourism and Education and Training career fields. Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America continues to encourage accessibility and provide opportunities for achievement and recognition for students with diverse backgrounds.

Composition:

The Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America Career Development Events Committee will be:

- A member in good standing with Ohio Association Teachers of Family and Consumer Sciences
- Twelve content subject matter experts, Post-Secondary Educators, business/industry partners and the Ohio Department of Education State Family and Consumer Sciences career field staff
- One (1) adviser from each content area with a total of three (3) advisers from each region
- Serve a two (2) year term from July 1 through June 30
- Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America Board of Directors will appoint representation to serve in an ex-officio capacity
- Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America Board of Directors members cannot serve concurrent time on the Career Development Events Committee



Ohio Family Career and Community Leaders of America

Operations:

- At least one (1) face-to-face meeting per year. The exact number of meetings will be determined by the needs of the Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America Association
- Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America Association state staff will develop an agenda for each meeting
- Discussion to obtain consensus will be the prevailing procedure used at meetings. It should be noted that committee activity is limited to suggestions, recommendations and assistance. Authority does not include administrative control of Ohio Family, Careers and Community Leaders of America Association programs; these are the responsibility of state staff.
- Minutes of meetings will be recorded and distributed for each meeting
