Official Dress Code Policy

Effective April 2019:

General Sessions - Business Session – Workshops – Career Development Events Recognition

- Professional white shirt
- Neckwear options can include the neckwear from the official emblematic supplier; black bow tie; single strand of pearls; red, black, and/or white scarf; or no neckwear
- Black bottoms (slacks, skirt, sheath dress)
- Shoes (black preferred)
- FCCLA red blazer
- Jeans, t-shirt, athletic wear are NOT acceptable

Exception: Culinary Arts participants are welcome to wear their chef's attire during the CDE Recognition Sessions.

Advisers/Chaperones/Guests

- Business professional
- Jeans, t-shirt, athletic wear are NOT acceptable

Career Development Events Participants

CDE participants are expected to adhere to the publicized dress code for all general sessions, workshops, and the CDE Recognition Session. For participation in competition, follow event specifications for dress, and wear appropriate clothing for the nature of the presentation, be prepared to change into clothing that meets conference dress code.
