Hospitality and Tourism

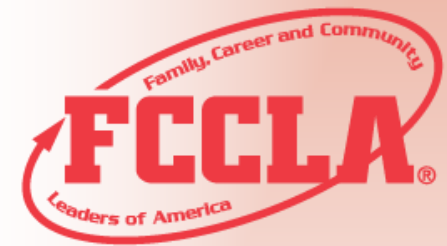
