The country I am in is very different from America though it is more progressive then your typical Arab country. The population is mostly made up of people from India, Pakistan and other countries that are not oil rich. Sounds great for some and not so great for the rest of the people. The temperature starts at low 90s when the sun comes up and hits 117 by mid day which is fairly unpleasant. I am thankful there is a swimming pool provided on base with a water cooler to make a great escape from the heat after work.

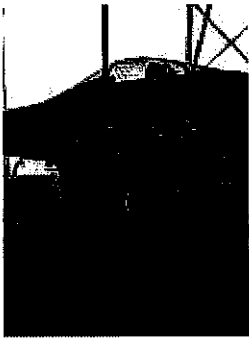
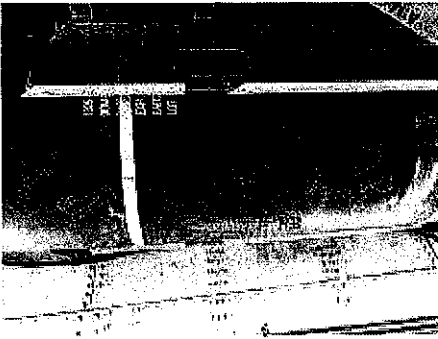
